



Pineapple Upside Down Cake

¼ c. butter
⅔ c. brown sugar
½ c. pecan meats
8 slices pineapple
8 maraschino cherries

Batter:

¼ c. shortening
¾ c. sugar
1 egg
½ c. milk
1 tsp. vanilla
1-½ c. flour
2-½ tsp. baking powder
½ tsp. salt

Melt butter for bottom in heavy pan or individual pie pans. Stir in brown sugar. Top with pineapple slices. Sprinkle nuts in between, and put a cherry in the center of each slice.

Make batter and pour over pineapple. Bake 45 minutes at 375°. Turn out on plate and serve warm with whipped cream.
